This course will serve as an update on latest diagnostic and therapeutic issues in GI and Hepatology. This program has been developed using a combination of lecture and case-based curriculum designed to serve as an intensive review tool for the GI and Hepatology Board Certification/Re-Certification Examination in 2024.

TARGET AUDIENCE

Physicians, trainees and health professionals with interest or clinical practice in Gastroenterology and Hepatology.

- Summarize the strategies for the diagnosis and management of esophageal dysphagia.
- Discuss current management in standard and advanced therapies of upper gastrointestinal bleeding.

- Outline updated guidelines in the management of cholestatic and autoimmune liver diseases.
